## ADVISEMENT

You are hereby advised that the law enforcement officer need not be present at the hearing unless you request his/her appearance in one of two ways:

- 1) You may request his/her appearance in writing at the time you request the hearing. If you make the request for the officer's presence at the time you request the hearing, the Department will issue a written notice for the officer to appear at the hearing.
- 2) If you do not make the request for the officer's appearance at the time you request the hearing, you may have the Hearings Division issue a subpoena for the appearance of the officer once you have received notice of the date and time of the hearing. You must make the request for the subpoena directly to the Hearings Division. Please allow two business days for the Division to generate the subpoena. Once the subpoena is issued, it is your responsibility to serve the subpoena. By law, law enforcement officers must be served at least five (5) calendar days before the date of the hearing. Please contact the Hearings Division at (303) 205-5606 for more information.

You are further advised that if the officer does not appear at the hearing, documents and an affidavit prepared and submitted by the officer will be used at the hearing.

You are further advised that you may review the documents and the affidavit submitted by the officer prior to the hearing.

Note: If the hearing is rescheduled at the request of the law enforcement officer, then the permit is extended until the rescheduled date of hearing.

Note: Pursuant to C.R.S. 42-2-132(2)(c), if you reinstate from this revocation prior to the hearing on the merits of the revocation, you waive the right to the hearing.
